MAKING DISCIPLES – PLANTING CHURCHES – REACHING NATIONS

1. Who should you be trying to reach?

Who is the Hero?

You are not the hero. Jesus is the hero and the people we are helping are the most important characters in God's plan of salvation.

What do the people who you help want?

Where should you be ministering?

1. **LRPG** There are 16,315 people groups. 6,564 of these people have not heard the Gospel.
2. **LRPG** (Least Reached People Groups) may not necessarily be in rural areas, since many of them are in cities. Indeed over half of the world's population is in cities. Strategies for reaching them there are needed, not just in the bush of Mozambique
3. **God is moving in the Global South-** The **Global South** is made up of Africa, Latin America, and in developing parts of Asia including the Middle East.
4. **Reverse Missions** - Those who received missionaries are now sending to those countries who were sending missionaries before. God is using what was once considered poorer, less developed Nations, such as Latin America, to send out missionaries
5. **Ripe Harvest Fields** - Concentrate on places where many people are making decisions to draw close to Christ and become His disciples. China, for example is wide open to the Gospel, even though the Country is closed to Christian Missionaries. (See Doug Gehman's book in "Resources")
6. **Focus on the younger generation** (predominately ripe harvest fields) who can be reached through **technology and social media**.
7. **We should be on mission where we live.** In addition to always being ready to share our faith in our daily activities we also have unique opportunities to minister to people who have moved to the USA from least reached nations.

Make a list of 100 people you relate to. Include friends, family, coworkers and neighbors. Start praying over this list. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you choose 5 people from the list you can invite to take the next step in their spiritual journey this week.

2. *What is standing in the way of reaching these people?*

What is the biggest reason why people do not share their faith on a personal level?

What is the biggest problem you encounter in fulfilling Gods Great Commission?

We need more disciples who will obey Christs command to make more disciples for Christ.

What is God Asking of Me?

Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying:

*“Whom shall I send,
And who will go for Us?”*

Reflection:

Ask yourself these questions:

“Do I really love God and other people so much so that I am willing to obey Christ’s great commission to share my faith not matter what the cost?”

“Am I a disciple worth reproducing?”

3. *How can you guide lost people to Christ*

How do you empathize with the lost?

We understand how it feels to be lost and without hope, to not have purpose and meaning. We understand this because we too were once lost and now we are saved.

Why are you qualified to help?

We are qualified guides because we have the power of the Holy Spirit in us to help guide others to Christ

Share Your Story

We all have a unique testimony of what God has done in our lives. You should be able to tell your personal story in 3 minutes.

Divide your testimony into 3 parts and share it with every person you want to disciple

1. What was my life like before I met Christ?
2. What were the circumstance that led me to meet Christ?
3. What is my life like now that I know Christ?

4. *What is Globe Internationals Plan to solve their problem?*

Reflection: If your desire is to reach multitudes in a short period of time, as a missionary you should be asking these 2 critical questions:

1. How many lost are there in your area or sphere of influence?
2. What can we do so God will bring salvation to them?

Goals

Our Goal is global worship of Christ.

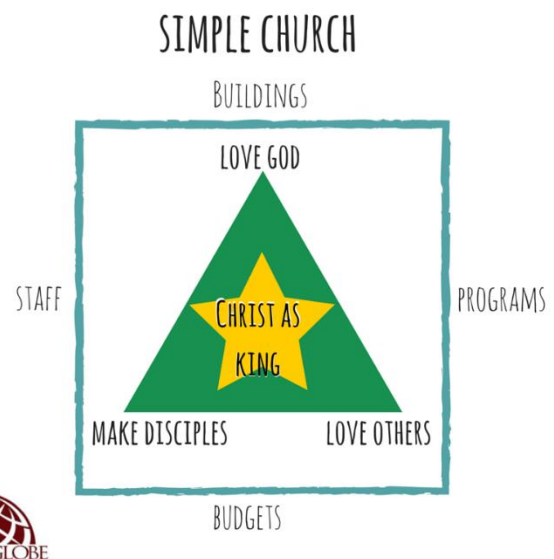
God's purpose in Missions is Global Worship. Evangelists can make the mistake of focusing on salvation through "repeat after me" sinners prayers. Doing so may be missing the mark and could even cause harm. Jesus calls us to Love and Worship Him through radical obedience (John 14:15), and because we love Him with our all, we will love others as God loves them, and because we love others we will disciple them to make more disciples.

The Goal of Missions is to make disciples and establish indigenous Churches

What is Globe DMM?

DMM - Disciple Making Movements - GC ² (squared) stands for Obeying the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:36-40) and the Great Commission (Matthew 28:16-20). GC ² is a great first step towards CPM and it may also be less intimidating for you as a Globe Missionary.

- **CPM** (Church Planting Movements) CPMs are the intentional formation of new groups/ simple churches, they don't just happen.
- **Every disciple a disciple-maker**, every home a training center, every simple church a mission's organization
- **Simple churches** (a group of believers of any size.)
 - Love God,
 - Love Others
 - Make Disciples.
 - GC ² is the purpose of Christ's Church. Not buildings, staff, programs or budgets.



Globe International 3 step plan to multiply disciples

How should we minister?

How does disciple making and church growth occur?

DMD/CPM Principles: The following concepts are part of our plan to be the most effective in bringing people to global worship and a relationship with Christ...

Preface: Let the Holy Spirit guide you

- Pray
- Ask for wisdom
- Be led by the Holy Spirit

1. Making Disciples who multiply disciples

Disciples making disciples are the basis of church growth and multiplication. A Church intentionally grows when it's not complicated and depends on the Holy Spirit.

Self-Feeding: We should be self-feeders characterized by:

1. Focused intercessory prayer
2. Time in the Word
3. Body life- Disciple making is not an individual sport, it's a team sport
4. Continually sharing our faith (Our Story and His Story)
5. Responding adequately to persecution and suffering.

Duckling Discipleship - Ducklings follow the mother duck.

The only mother duck in disciple making is Jesus Christ, the rest of us are all ducklings. In order to lead other ducklings you don't have to be a mature duck, you just have to be one step ahead.

GC² Groups/Churches- Cast Vision, encourage obedience, and multiply disciples in small groups by going from house-to-house **Acts 2:44-47**

GC² groups (handout GC² format and principles)

Train leaders and missionaries for Church multiplication

Remember, you are a guide, a facilitator, not the hero....

Look for and work through Persons of Peace. People who have influence among People groups

Provide leadership without ownership and control. Train leaders who train leaders. Equip and empower national leaders to do the work since they will do it better than you. Let go as soon as possible. "I can do it, not America can do it for me." This change in mentality is one of the biggest issues we have to face. Real friendship relationships are much more effective than foreigner vs national ministry

“Mentoring” and “Spiritual fathering” are not only Biblical (II Tim 2:2), but effective DMD Methods. Mentor spiritual sons and/or daughters on the condition that he/she takes what he learns and mentors or trains at least one other person

Implement DMM in Helps Ministries by Helping without Hurting - Some will be called to help the poor, since it's the heart of Jesus. Appropriate humanitarian aid results when we avoid the North American mistake of applying relief in situations in which rehabilitation or development is the appropriate intervention. **Avoid Paternalism.** **“Do not do things for people that they can do for themselves.”** (from When Helping Hurts book).

Rethink “buildings/properties” mentality - Many Christian churches are slaves to buildings since they are financed and most of Church budgets go towards paying that debt. Many underdeveloped and even modern nations have no large protestant “church/temple” structures. This could be considered an advantage since house-to-house movements and disciples-multiplying-disciples is the most effective way to quickly reach the lost.

Use Technology and modern media *to reach the lost (concentrate on the younger generation)*

Communicate the Gospel through storytelling.

Keep it simple and rely on the Holy Spirit for guidance. These concepts are not a plan in a box. **Be flexible** as you apply these principles to your particular people group, culture or ministry.

3. Reaching Nations

I know you want to fulfill the great commission but maybe you don't have the ability to go.

Here's a simple 3 step plan to help you reach nations

3 step implementation:

1. **Learning** – Get DMM training, Sign up for missionary newsletters, visit missionary websites and use the recommended resources included in this guide.
2. **Becoming** – Begin sharing your faith right where you are.
3. **Going**- Partnering with a Missionary is a Biblical method for obeying the Great Commission if you are not able to physically go to another country. Partnerships include praying for and financially investing in Missionaries ministries.

LRPG (Least Reached People Groups) Statistics

God has been working in our hearts, continually reminding us of the need to reach the least reached nations and disciple them to multiply disciples:

- There are 7,275,084,000 people in the world today.
- There are 3,067,186,000 (41% of the world's population) un-reached people in the world today.
- 1,600,000,000 of these people live in South Asia
- There are 16,315 people groups. 6,564 OF THOSE GROUPS ARE UNREACHED

PACE - Time Matters - **Rabbits vs Elephants** - Every Soul entering into eternity without Christ is robbing God of a willing worshiper.

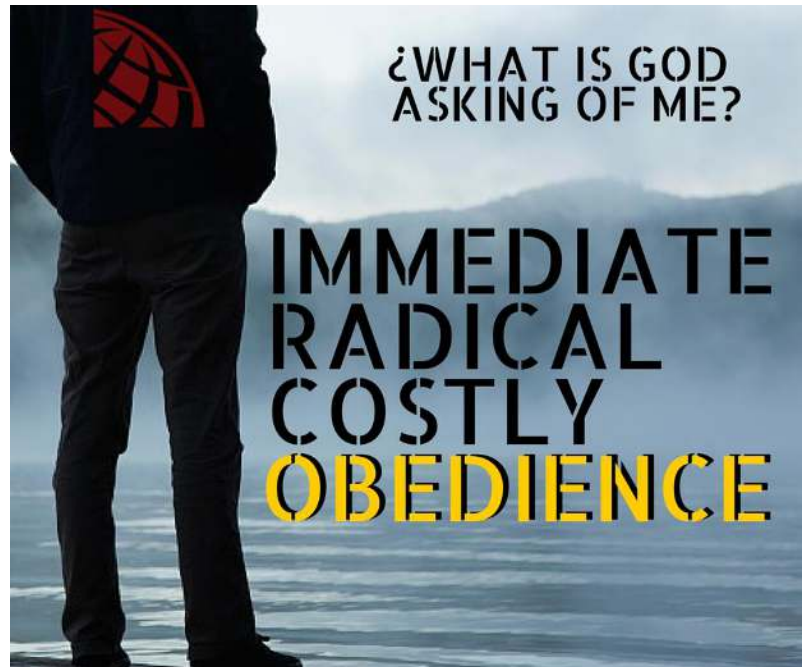
Immediate Radical Costly Obedience

6. Measurable Results

Success- How will the people you help have better lives because you were obedient and helped them?

How can we know we're getting successful results?

- **By focusing on Jesus work of reconciliation:** moving people closer to glorifying God by living in right relationship with God, with self, with others, and with the rest of creation.
- **Don't fall into the North American trap of measuring results monetarily or through emotional responses** (smiling faces), met physical needs, spiritual results measured only by numbers, large gatherings of people or completed church buildings.
- **Personal testimonies** are a good way to measure Godly result's
- **When you disciple someone who in turn makes more disciples who makes more disciples that's success.**

Reflection: What tragedies will occur if you are not obedient and do not help the lost people?
